Re: Information for General Dental Practitioners working in Wales

I hadn't intended to write to you again so soon but there are two items of news from England that I thought it was important you should be made aware of.

Public Health England have now published version 3 of the evidence based prevention toolkit '*Delivering Better Oral Health'*. This toolkit has been completely updated and contains the most up to date evidence on prevention of oral disease. We have arranged for each dental practice in Wales to receive a hard copy of this document. This will be delivered in the next 2-3 months. In addition I am making arrangements the electronic version to be placed on the Information for Professionals webpage of <a href="https://www.designedtosmile.co.uk">www.designedtosmile.co.uk</a>, where it can be downloaded if required.

In my last letter I set out Welsh Government's position regarding contractual developments. Since then the Department of Health have issued an open consultation 'Improving Dentistry' which is seeking views on contract reform in England.
