Local Implementation Group, 1,000 lives. Chair, Ros Davies.

104 care homes in ABMU.

26 care homes fully participating in the 1,000 lives 'Homecare Improvement Programme'. The target is to reach 37 homes. At present this initiative does not include mouthcare and that is the purpose of this group is to try and include it which will mean investment by the HB.

A questionable strategy by the HB in place for coping with all this number. The hope is that following the reorganization there will be management groups set up to deal with it and look at data for future planning. Domiciliary dental care needs additional commissioning of Services as well as the CDS.

ABMU threw out the case for high fluoride toothpaste supply for elderly patients (2,500 to 5,000 ppm)

Aneurin Bevan HB provides F varnishing for patients as well as high F toothpastes.

The Welsh initiative called "Gwen am Byth" (Everlasting Smile) has been launched with a training process for care home staff. Evidence of reduced incidents of candida infections and chest infections necessitating antifungals and Ab's reported.

Unfortunately, the data is not being gathered as well as it might to demonstrate these improvements and a discussion around this problem may have the effect that nursing inspectors might be able to gather the data as part of their reviews.

A worry that with reduced staffing levels in the CDS that this service will struggle to cope. The LDC concerns regarding adequate commissioning of domiciliary services to cope with the demand were also highlighted.
