Referral Management Centre

(Previously known as Single Point of Access (SPA))

Thank you for your continued co-operation and support with the newly developed paediatric dental GA pathway. This has proven to be very successful to date.

The referrals from the Orthodontists will continue to go directly to Parkway as has been prescribed in the protocol. The pathway will be subjected to a few changes in the near future, to be in line with the new Sedation guidelines and you will be updated once it has been finalised.

Key Messages for GDPs

- If you have any queries or concerns prior to sending your referral, we would recommend you contact the orthodontist in the first instance to confirm the referral is appropriate
- Please ensure that patients are appropriately referred at the correct age for orthodontic treatment. Early referrals that are inappropriate at the age of referral only contributes to increasing the waiting times of our current waiting list for first assessment

Key Messages for Orthodontic Providers

- To routinely monitor your waiting list submitted to the Health Board and continually cleanse your data so that those patients who have completed their treatment are no longer on the system
- Please ensure that all patients referred and are nearing their 18th birthday are prioritised for assessment so that treatment commences prior to the age of 18

Authorisation Process for a Request for Orthodontic Treatment of Patients who do not meet the NHS criteria

The new approval / authorisation process to request orthodontic treatment of patients who do not meet the NHS criteria is being developed by the Health Board to ensure a robust and fair appraisal of all requests.

It is requested that in the notes for each patient the following information is recorded: (this will ensure a prompt response from the Health Board and the Ombudsman)

Radiograph assessment in line with IRMER regulations:

- Radiograph interpretation
- Radiograph grading for quality

Options appraisal:

All options clearly stated with risks and benefits or each

Reason for retreat request:

• ie. Unfavourable growth
